ORDER

For the reasons stated in the Court's accompanying Memorandum Opinion, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Plaintiffs' motion for default judgment is **GRANTED**. It is further **ORDERED** that final judgment is granted in Plaintiffs' favor and against Defendant. In addition, it is **ORDERED** that Plaintiffs shall receive \$27,232,031 in compensatory damages, and \$81,696,093 in punitive damages, divided in the following amounts:

It is further **ORDERED** that each plaintiff is awarded post-judgment interest on their compensatory damages award at the statutory rate. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 1961(a).

This is a final, appealable order. The Clerk of Court is directed to close the case.
